INTRODUCTION

The ruins at Casigliano are made up of the former homes of those who worked the fields on this breathtakingly beautiful estate. Available to purchase individually, the ruins are set apart from each other and thus each one is guaranteed absolute privacy. United by the incredible view and their extraordinary potential, but marked out by their own particularities, you can visit them all before choosing your favourite.

La Gattuccia, also known as The Pine House because of the maritime pine that grows next to it.

La Fornace, also known as The Tobacco Tower, because it was formerly used for drying tobacco leaves.
