INTRODUCTION

The property is composed of two adjacent units located in the same estate, just outside Gubbio. The comfortable accommodation offered by the spacious three-bedroom property, on three floors, is extended by virtue of the beautifully restored small chapel immediately in front which provides a one bedroom master suite with absolutely stunning, unspoiled views to the high peaks of the Appenine mountains.

The renovation of the entire San Vittorino estate has been carried out with considerable attention to detail and the use of recovered material. San Vittorino traces its history back over millennian from mediaeval origins as a watchtower for a returning crusader, developed to become a monastery then farm buildings, until its thorough renovation to provide comfortable modern living within original rustic charm. The entire complex is composed by six private and indipendet units.

Pietrachiars enjoys private outdoor lawns and

planting which surround the chapel. To the front of the main building is a generous terrace, together with a spacious covered area which provides ideal shade for dining on hot days and picture-perfect

The ground floor living is open plan with a kitchen, dining room and a welcoming, comfortable sitting area, French doors lead directly onto a large terrace. The kitchen is a modern Italian design and a 'lookthrough' fireplace opens to both the kitchen and the dining area. A stone staircase leads to the master bedroom with en-suite bathroom and dressing area on the first floor, with gorgeous hillside views. Ascending another flight of stone stairs takes you to the two bedrooms with two bathrooms on the top floor, again with lovely views over unspoilt countryside.

The chapel is on a single floor with direct access through large arched doors to the sitting room. The bedroom is to the rear and the end wall has a wonderful restored fresco of St. Ubaldo which the expert fresco restorers identify as being from the 17th century with an original overpainted fresco showing beneath which dates back to the 15th century. The bedroom has an en-suite bathroom, and to the side of the living room with open fireplace is a modern Italian galley kitchen. Throughout Pietrachiara there is exposed stonework, antique chestnut beams and beautiful original hand-cut terracotta floor tiles.

BEDROOMS

The master bedroom with king size bed and en suite bathroom is on the first floor. The second floor has two further bedrooms, each with twin beds and their own bathroom.

BATHROOMS

All bedrooms have bathrooms en-ensuite.

KITCHEN



The ground floor living is open plan with a kitchen/dining room. The kitchen is a modern Italian design with granite worktops and has a "look-through" fireplace, accessed also from the sitting room. The same style kitchen is also present in the chapel, with connection outside as well.

LIVINGROOM

Large lounge with open fireplace, open plan fully fitted kitchen with appliances, dining room.

OTHER ROOMS

Small pantry area under the stairs, with access from the living area and a storage at the first floor next to the bathroom.

In the private garden irrigated lawn is present. A patio area as well as a covered outdoor area are available, with access from the living room. Both the shared swimming pool as well as a shared tennis court are a small walk away, and parking space for cars is on the front drive. Part of the property consists also of shares in agricultural land.

TECHNICAL

The house is connected to electricity, LPG for heating. Water is provided by a spring, with a pump connected to a 70.000 lt of capacity. Sewage system is by a septic tank and natural dispersion. Heating is through radiators. Double glazed windows with mosquito nets are
