



Privacy terms

SpecialUmbria ("SU") respects its clients privacy and is committed to ensuring that it is protected. In the following privacy terms ("Privacy terms") you can read which information SU requires from you as its client and how SU uses this information.

Automatically Collected Information

The following information is automatically recorded on the SU server when you visit the SU website www.specialumbria.com, further named as 'our website':

- the pages which are visited, for SU statistics;
- your IP address (a unique number which is automatically assigned to your computer by your internet provider when you enter the internet), in order to be able to identify you as a unique visitor for SU statistics;
- the name of your computer system and type of internet browser, so that SU may continue to improve the systems which its visitors use, and so that SU will be able to solve any potential future problems. No personal information whatsoever will be read from your computer through this process. In addition, under no circumstances this information will be used to personally identify you.

Cookies

Our website uses cookies. These are temporary files on your computer in which information is saved for use on our website. SU use the cookies for Google Analytics. The information generated by the cookie about your use of our website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States of America. Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of our website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of our website. By using our website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above. On our website SU also uses AddThis for which cookies are collected.

Your Personal Information

When you book a short term rental or you buy a real estate property through SU, you are automatically added to its customer address file. SU will use your information to inform you of the status of your reservation and payment and send you the necessary details about your stay. In case of purchasing real estate SU will use the information only to communicate directly with you. SU will in no case provide your personal information to any third party unless explicitly authorized by you.

If applicable, personal identification information will be sent through an encrypted connection to and stored on the servers of Amazon Web Services in Dublin. Provision of this information is mandatory by Italian law and will only be shared with the Italian authorities. All provided personal identification information will be destroyed within 2 weeks after a rental period has ended.
